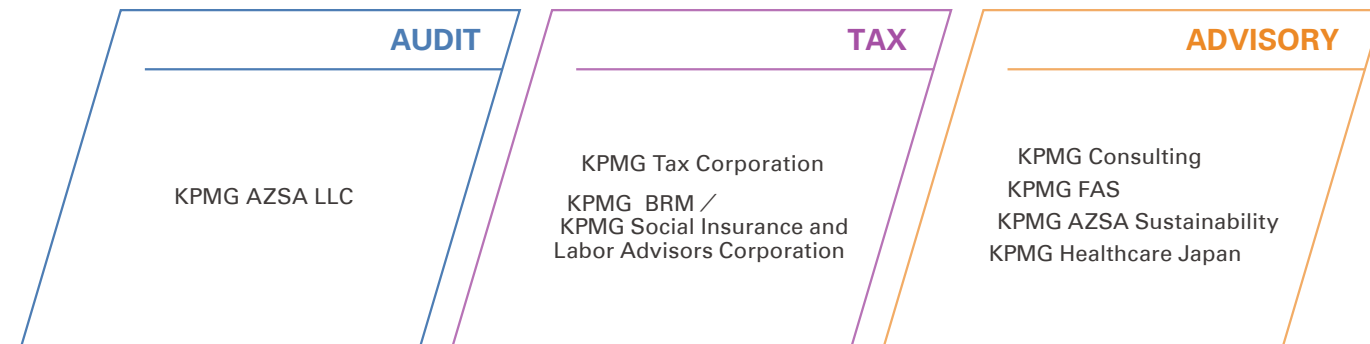

Introduction

KPMG will host the "KPMG IFRS Conference 2014 – The Future With IFRS" with contributions from the IFRS Foundation on the afternoon of September 3, 2014 in Tokyo.

Since the change of government in 2012, there has been a shift in the movement of IFRS in Japan. The Japan Federation of Economic Organizations, the Financial Services Agency and the Liberal Democratic Party have issued recommendations and policies regarding IFRS in 2013, and as a result, voluntary adoption of IFRS is gradually increasing across various industries.

We hope this event will be an opportunity to assist participants to gain an increased understanding of the direction of IFRS, as well as how IFRS adoption can benefit Japanese companies.



To highlight the event, we will invite Mr. Hans Hoogervorst and Mr. Takatsugu Ochi from the IASB to describe the recent developments in IFRS and the future direction of the IASB. We will also invite representatives of leading Japanese companies that have decided to voluntarily adopt IFRS to participate in a panel discussion on their global IFRS strategies. In the morning prior to this event, we will hold a Pre-Conference session focused on the Leases Project to discuss the recent developments as well as the major impacts that the proposals will have in practice.
